ORDER

On June 2, 2017, the Court held a telephone status conference with all counsel of record to discuss the above-captioned case and reset certain exceptions for hearing. As discussed, agreed, and ordered during this status conference:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following Exceptions, which were previously set for hearing on May 30, 2017, will be heard on August 25, 2017, at 9:30 a.m.:

- Exception of Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction filed by Milliman, Inc.
- Exception of Improper Venue filed by Buck Consultant, LLC
- Exception of Prematurity/Alternative Motion to Stay Proceedings filed by Beam Partners, LLC

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Affidavit of Harvey Sobel submitted by Buck Consultants, LCC, as Exhibit A to its pending Exception, will be considered by the Court, subject to Plaintiff's objections based upon relevance, without the need for Mr. Sobel to appear and testify live in Court;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Exception of Prescription filed by Group Resources, Inc. and the Motion for Summary Judgment filed by CGI Technologies and Solutions, Inc. will be heard, as previously ordered, on August 25, 2017, at 9:30 a.m.;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, given the reported settlement agreement between Plaintiff and Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America, including its insureds (the D&O defendants), all of the Exceptions filed herein by these parties will not be heard; specifically, the Exception of Prescription filed by Warner Thomas and the Exception of Prescription filed by Terry Shilling will no longer be set for hearing on August 25, 2017; and the Exceptions of No Right of

Action, No Cause of Action, Vagueness and Ambiguity filed by Warner Thomas, William Oliver, Patrick Powers, Terry Shilling, George Cromer and Charles Calvi, and the Exception of No Cause of Action filed by Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America will no longer be set for hearing on September 25, 2017:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, unless specifically modified by this ORDER, the prior ORDER of this Court signed and issued on April 26, 2017, will control the disposition of this matter.
