MOTION FOR APPROVAL TO DISPOSE OF MARKETING MATERIALS

NOW INTO COURT, through the undersigned counsel comes LOUISIANA HEALTH COOPERATIVE, INC. (hereinafter "LAHC") appearing herein through Billy J. Bostick, court appointed Receiver of LAHC by order of this Court, who respectfully represents that:

1.

LAHC was placed in rehabilitation by this Court on September 1, 2015.

2.

As part of doing business, LAHC prepared and retained marketing material for use in the promotion of LAHC's business. An inventory of the excess marketing material presently being stored by LAHC is attached as Exhibit A, and the materials consist mainly of various items such as stickers, cups, balls, plastic bags, brochures, and other similar type items that have no monetary value to LAHC.

3.

These marketing items are maintained at the LAHC office in Metairie, Louisiana; however, due to downsizing and relocation of staff to one half of the original rental space, there is limited storage and the removal of these items will enable the Receiver to better utilize the space for receivership records.

4.

Since LAHC is no longer engaged in the business of offering health care coverage to the public, there is no need to retain these items and that it is in the best interest of the estate to dispose of them.

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5.

The Receiver will retain sample copies of each type of marketing material in the event such is needed for any reason in the LAHC receivership.

6.

The Receiver requests that he be authorized to dispose of the marketing items listed on **Exhibit A** in the most cost effective manner determined by the Receiver.

WHEREFORE, the Receiver prays that this honorable Court issue an order authorizing him to destroy the LAHC marketing materials shown on **Exhibit A** in the most cost effective manner as determined by the Receiver and to retain representative samples of each, and for all other appropriate relief.


