### **Definitions:**

• Certificate of Destruction - a type of title issued for a water-damaged vehicle, other than an antique vehicle or a vehicle in excess of twenty thousand pounds gross weight, whose power train, computer, or electrical system has been damaged by flooding as the result of a gubernatorial declared disaster or emergency and has been declared a "total loss".

## Requirements:

- An insurance company that acquires ownership of a vehicle MUST apply for a certificate of destruction within thirty days. A 60-day extension period may be granted upon approval by the Office of Motor Vehicles, not to exceed ninety days from the date of settlement. The following must be submitted:
  - o Current Louisiana Certificate of Title properly assigned, if applicable.
  - A completed vehicle application form (<u>DPSMV1799</u>) for the certificate of destruction.
    The words "Certificate of Destruction" must be written or stamped on the application and on the face of the accompanying title.
  - A copy of the total loss settlement indicating the date of loss as well as the date of settlement.
  - Disclosure of Salvage/Reconstructed/Water Damaged/Hail Damaged Vehicle (<u>DPSMV1637</u>)
  - Applicable title and handling fee

#### Notes:

- An insurance company may elect to apply for a Certificate of Destruction for a vehicle that has been damaged to the extent it is deemed a "total loss" even if not resulting from a gubernatorial declared disaster. If the insurance company elects to apply for a Certificate of Destruction in lieu of a salvage title, a statement indicating such must be added to the proof of loss documentation and submitted with the file.
- A certificate of destruction will not be issued to off road vehicles, manufactured homes or trailers.
