

## **Enrollment Periods for Part C and Part D**

Every year, you have a chance to make changes to your Medicare Advantage or Medicare prescription drug coverage for the following year. There are two separate enrollment periods each year.

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| October 15 - December 7  Open Enrollment Period for Medicare Advantage AND Medicare prescription drug coverage                                                          | <ul> <li>Change from Original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage Plan.</li> <li>Change from a Medicare Advantage Plan back to Original Medicare.</li> <li>Switch from one Medicare Advantage Plan to another Medicare Advantage Plan.</li> <li>Switch from a Medicare Advantage Plan that does not offer drug coverage to a Medicare Advantage Plan that offers drug coverage.</li> <li>Switch from a Medicare Advantage Plan that offers drug coverage to a Medicare Advantage Plan that does not offer drug coverage.</li> <li>Join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.</li> <li>Switch from one Medicare Prescription Drug Plan to another Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.</li> <li>Drop your Medicare prescription drug coverage completely.</li> </ul> |  |
| January 1 - March 31  Beneficiaries who enroll in a Medicare Advantage Plan during Open Enrollment can make changes during the first three months of the new plan year. | <ul> <li>If you enroll in a Medicare Advantage Plan, as of January 1 you can:         <ul> <li>Leave your plan and switch to Original Medicare. If you switch to Original Medicare during this period you will have until March 31 to also join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.
